Seiichi Mizuno started his career in The Seibu Department Stores Ltd. The great success of the new concept enabled Shibuya to establish its identity as "The Information and Trend Center of Japan."

After resigning as CEO of The Seibu Department Stores Ltd., Mizuno was appointed as a Special Guest Professor at Keio University, where he specialized in social marketing. He also started consulting services in the IT business by introducing the internet browser software firm, Netscape Communications Corporation, into the Japanese market.

From 1995 until July, 2001, he served as a Member of the House of Councilors. During this period, he conducted environmental improvements for venture businesses, and focused upon the importance of social marketing in politics. As a social producer, he has been energetically involved in cultural activities. He influences the design industry in Japan mainly through the activities of Japan Inter-Design Forum, where he has been serving as Chairperson.

Since he established his company, Institute of Marketing Architecture Co., Ltd. in 1995, he has been providing consulting services to international as well as domestic leading companies. He has been involved in numerous large-scale commertial complex and area developments, including the basic concept development of Roppongi Hills and Omote-sando Hills of Mori Building Co., Ltd. as their special advisor. He also provides consultancy sevices to various

international companies and brands for their launch into the Japanese market, including Hongkong and Shanghai Hotels, Ltd. for The Peninsula Hotel, Tokyo project.

In cooperation with international and domestic funds, he provides consultancy services in restructuring program development, and in finance and marketing to domestic venture corporations.
